- RE:Flex warper and morpher -- With RE:Vision Effects' RE:Flex plug-in, warping is directed through the combustion 3 rotoscoping tools rather than with a grid of tedious mesh points. The result is a seamless and intuitive workflow with no learning curve. Integrated into combustion 3 at no additional cost, users save close to US\$600.
