By developing more innovative machines faster and less expensively, Coil Master also hopes to increase its Asian market share beyond the current 10 percent. Specifically, the Coil Master representative said that Autodesk Inventor software cut the time from conceptualization to the production design from four months to two months. "Our design project costs have been slashed in half, and we are now able to reuse designs, altering only certain specifications and measurements," Mr. Tan explained. "The library tool enabled my team to easily revise designs. In addition, the software lets my team break apart their designs and thoroughly look through each part for specific measurements, and later reassemble them to demonstrate exactly how the proposed machine would function."

Coil Master specializes in the design, fabrication, and assembly of mosquito coil making machines for the Asian market. These coils emit a slow burning mosquito repellant and are widely used in warmer climates. They are more popular in areas where mosquito-transmitted diseases like Malaria are present.
