Growing Korean Building Market

After enduring a significant downturn during the Asian recession of the late 1990s, the Korean construction market began to recover in 2001 and is expected to continue growing at steady rate over the next three years. In recent publications the Construction & Economy Research Institute of Korea and The Construction Association of Korea forecast that construction spending, which totaled US \$50 billion in 2001, will grow to more than US \$90 billion in 2005. This growth is being spurred by a boom in housing construction -- especially in the multi-unit apartment sector -- and rapid growth in overseas work for Korean-based companies.
